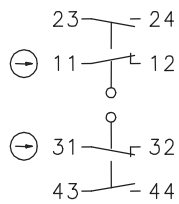

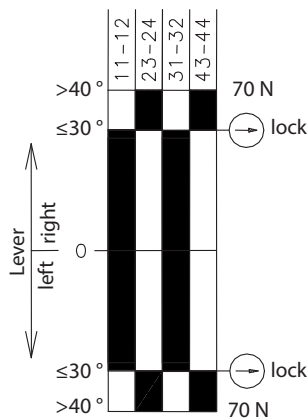

Operating symbol

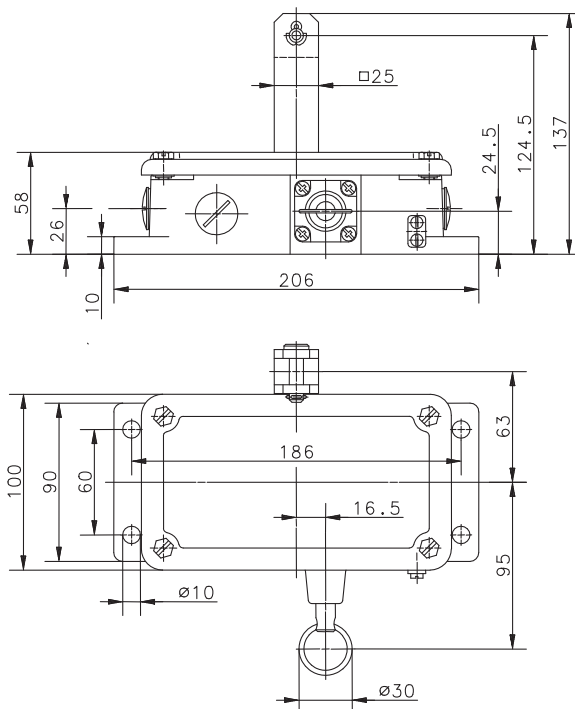


Operating diagram
