

CE MARKING

CE marking is an European Community scheme and is an indication by the manufacturer or importer into the European Community that the product complies with the essential requirements of the relevant Directive. The purpose of this marking is to allow them to be sold anywhere within the European Community thereby removing a technical barrier to trade. There are several directives affecting electrical and cable management products as follows...

- The EMC Directive: SCHLEMMER Products are considered passive with respect to EMC and are therefore not covered by EMC Directive, however several SCHLEMMER products do possess good EMI Screening properties.
- The Low Voltage Directive (LVD): All SCHLEMMER S-TEC products, with very few exceptions are CE marked to the LVD. The LVD does not require any third party certification, it only requires a self declaration from the manufacturer.

CE marking may be on the product or on the packaging or both.

Whilst CE marking indicates that certain basic requirements are satisfied, it is no indication or guarantee of product quality.
