## ASR-Soft Installation

## Installation on Windows® Vista and Windows® 7

(1) Insert the ASR-soft CD into the CD-ROM drive of your computer/laptop. The installation wizard starts automatically and a Welcome screen appears, as shown below. In case the Auto run feature is disabled in your Windows<sup>®</sup> settings, use Windows<sup>®</sup> explorer to access the 'setup.msi' file. Double-click the icon 'setup.msi' and the welcome screen appears.

If you have downloaded the folder containing the ASR-Soft Setup then the installation process has to be done manually. For this, double-click the 'setup.msi' file in the folder and continue the installation process once the Welcome screen appears.

In the Welcome screen, click the Next button to continue.



(3) Click on "Next" to start installation.



(5) Then Driver Installation window will display. Click on "Install" to start installation.



7 Restart your PC after installing the software, to complete the installation. After your PC has restarted, you can run the ASR-SOFT. (2) When prompted for the destination directory as shown below, user can either select the default directory (C:\Program Files\Altech Smart Relay\ASR-SOFT) or enter another destination directory for the installation files.
