Safety Lock and Manual Release





Pedal pushed up to pressure point:


The make contact is closed and the work process is started

Pedal pushed beyond resistance of the pressure point in an emergency situation:

The make contact is interrupted and locked, the work process interrupted. The lock remains in the off position without pressure, preventing an uncontrolled restart.


Release:

After the hazardous situation has been fixed, pressing the blue manual release button resets the contact and allows the work process to restart.



Enabling Foot Switches

Circuit symbol









When the pedal is pushed up to the pressure point, the two enabling contact close allow the process to start. If the pedal is released or if the pedal is press past the pressure point the two enabling contacts will open, stopping the work process. When the pedal is pushed to the bottom position, the enabling contacts will remain open through the center position when released. A programmable contact with a PNP output is also provided to indicated the foot switch position.
